



# 2022 GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS

The 2022 election did not bring many changes to South Dakota's capitol. Legislatively, Republicans appear to have lost a seat in the Senate while picking up a seat in the House. The Republicans will still hold a super-majority in both chambers as it is projected to be 31-4 in the Senate and 63-7 in the House. There are three possible recounts that could affect these numbers. Governor Kristi Noem will continue to serve as South Dakota's Governor.

Two of the three ballot measures that SDFB opposed were indeed defeated – legalizing recreational marijuana and the slaughterhouse ordinance in Sioux Falls. Medicaid expansion did pass, which SDFB opposed.
