ELIGIBIITY GUIDELINES:

- 1. Applicant, applicant's parents, or guardian must be a current member of Pennington/Jackson County Farm Bureau and must have been a member for two years.

- 4. High School Senior applications must include a copy of most recent ACT score. All applicants must include current transcript with grade point average.
- 5. Graduate students are not eligible for this scholarship.
- 6. Scholarship is applied toward tuition fees only, and will be awarded after the first semester.

The following information will be considered in selecting Scholarship recipients:

- 1. Academic performance, honors, and ACT score.
- 2. Leadership abilities and involvement in activities.
- 3. Agriculture impacts all areas of our daily lives. How will your chosen career path affect rural America?
- 4. A brief statement explaining your determination to succeed in your chosen field.
- 5. Two signed and currently dated letters of recommendation that demonstrate the student's moral character and potential for successful completion of a course of study.

Please include with your application:

- 1. Official high school transcript and ACT scores or official college transcript.
- 2. Two reference letters.
- 3. A copy of the Letter of Acceptance from the qualified school you are planning to attend. College students please include a letter from qualifying school confirming your enrollment acceptance.
