

## **2026 Legislative Issues**

#### **Taxation**

- Continue implementation of the productivity-based system to ensure assessed valuations accurately reflect productivity.
- Take action to defend agricultural property owners from property tax shifts.
- Advocate for fiscally responsible means of taxation at the local and state levels.

#### **Health Care**

• Protect and grow South Dakota Farm Bureau Health Plans.

### **Infrastructure**

Continue to improve farm-to-market roads and bridges.

• Continue focusing on protecting the property rights of South Dakota farmers and ranchers.

# **Livestock Regulation**

- Protect livestock producers through the reissuance of the state general permit for concentrated animal feeding operations.
- Advocate for improvements and efficiencies within the brand board and brand inspection program.

## **Risk Management**

- Monitor shifts in political climates related to consumer perceptions about food production and agricultural practices.
- Defend agricultural producers from unnecessary and burdensome environmental legislation and/or regulations.

#### **Political Involvement**

• Grow the South Dakota Farm Bureau PAC to strengthen the ability to support pro-agriculture candidates.

### **Value-Added Agriculture**

- Improve the local zoning process to expand new and existing agriculture production opportunities in the state.
- Support exploration into value-added markets that are science-based, meet safety standards, protect landowner rights, and meet all regulatory requirements.
